




Board Certification of the CEQA Document

Why study alternatives?

- Required part of CEQA and NEPA
- Avoid impacts
- Minimize impacts
- Public input
- Stakeholder input
- Coordinate with other agency studies
- Cost savings
- Travel time savings

Preferred Alternative

Station Alternatives

- Southfront Road Station Alternative (Livermore)—Alternative to Greenville Station.
- Mountain House Station Alternative—Alternative to Mountain House Station.

Parking Alternatives

- Downtown Tracy Station Parking Alternative 1 three-level parking structure at the site of the existing surface parking lot
- Downtown Tracy Station Parking Alternative 2 three-level parking structure at the southwest corner of the North Central Avenue/West Sixth Street intersection

West Tracy OMF- Alternative to Tracy OMF

Alignment Alternative

 Stone Cut Alignment Alternative – Alternative to the SP Alignment Tunnel

Permitting & Mitigation


- On preferred Alternative only









Valley Link CEQA Certified Alternative — Adopted May 2021
