On behalf of the Contra Costa Building and Construction Trades Council, I am writing to express our strong support for the delivery strategy for Valley Link as proposed by staff.

The model being proposed, adheres to the original project vision of connecting BART with ACE in the Tri-Valley. It provides immediate benefits to San Joaquin County commuters as they will now be able to connect directly to Valley Link (and ultimately BART) from any ACE station throughout the San Joaquin Valley.
